asualty Clearing Stations needed to be close enough to the ontline to be able to deal quickly with the wounded, but far nough away to have some protection from shelling. triage system was used to divide the wounded into groups in he clearing stations. Those who were not likely to survive would aly be made comfortable, but not treated.

The answer has identified two features and describes them in more detail. The location of the Casualty Clearing Stations is described very clearly. The system of sorting patients is given its technical name and an example of one group is described.
